- 1. The Applicant must be currently registered in Boy Scouting, Girl Scouting or Camp Fire and be able to verify a minimum of five (5) years service in the Scouting movement.

(Besides Religious Emblems counselors this requirement would apply to Unit Leaders, Unit Committee members and others who can demonstrate they have assisted boys or girls in the completion of their Religious Emblem qualification)
